Who should participate? EAMS members who have experience in adult education teaching airway management on regular base, and want to improve how airway management will be taught at their institutions or societies. If you want to start teaching an EAMS TAT-course – that Master Class is the place for you.

Aim of the TAT-Master Class: Participants will learn the aims and goals of the EAMS TAT-course. They will get insight into the needed competences, facilities, logistics and team requirements to organize a TAT-course, and learn about the teaching and educational background to deliver an EAMS TAT-course. Participants will get opportunities to discuss problem solving strategies and handling of difficult candidates on TAT-courses.

Costs: € 300,-

Participants need to be EAMS member and must have successfully completed the EAMS TAT-course. Participants should provide proof on clinical teaching of airway management, and they are willing to implement local TAT-courses with support from the local EAMS council or national anaesthesia society to implement TAT. Command of English language is necessary to attend the Master Class.

A maximum of 18 participants will be accepted. They will be selected after application to the EAMS secretary. In case of too many applications for this first Master Class, EAMS will limit participation to two delegates from each country.
